

## How to Knit I-Cord

Cast on number of stitches to a double-pointed needle, usually 3-5.



Knit the stitches, from the left needle to the right, as you normally would.



The working yarn is attached to the far-left stitch on the right needle. Slide the stitches from one end of the needle to the other.



## How to Knit I-Cord



Do not turn the needle, but place it in your left hand. The working yarn is still coming from the far-left stitch and should be pulled across the back snugly. Knit the stitches from the left to the right needle. Slide to the other end of the double pointed needle, before knitting again.



Repeat procedure until you have the length of I-cord required. Pull the yarn snugly across the back at the beginning of each row, as this will help to ensure that stitches will be even. Bind off normally or thread tail through stitches and fasten off.
